## Subject Matter/Remarks

Both stated they have known CARL JOHNSON for about ten years and that he goes by C. J. PARKER. ROBERT stated he used to play drums and met JOHNSON when a friend of his arranged for him to play a "gig" with JOHNSON while JOHNSON was touring the Tucson area. The McWILLIAMS' stated they remained friends with JOHNSON after that and allowed him to stay at their home from time-to-time when he visited Tucson. His last visit was in February 1998 when he showed up unannounced at their former address located at 2443 Calle Sin Condena in Tucson. He stayed with them for a few weeks then moved out to stay with other friends in the Tucson area. The only friend he stayed with that they knew by name was LINDA LOU REED. Prior to the February visit, they had not seen JOHNSON for three years.

During JOHNSON'S stay in Tucson, from February until August 1998, they knew he traveled back and forth to Austin, Texas. They do not know what he did there, or with whom he met.

They stated JOHNSON never mentioned having any trouble with Canadian or United States Law Enforcement Authorities. However, after his August 1998 arrest, JOHNSON'S sister ALIA JOHNSON came to their home and told them JOHNSON was in trouble in Canada and in the United States. ALIA told them it had something to do with making threats and getting his Canadian nephew involved in "something illegal" in Canada. They told ALIA not to give them details, because they didn't want to believe JOHNSON was that kind of person. ALIA also told them that JOHNSON had set fire to a building she owned that had been located behind her home. No address or location was given. PAULINE stated that she thought JOHNSON'S mother died four years ago of cancer, but ROBERT corrected her and stated she died in a fire. ROBERT was asked if he was implying that JOHNSON had something to do with his mother's death. ROBERT provided no answer.

Both stated they never heard JOHNSON make any threatening statements or ever saw him hurt anyone. However, both stated JOHNSON got "weird" if he failed to take his medication for Tourettes' Syndrome. The McWILLIAMS' stated that while staying with them JOHNSON was seen by Doctor EDWARD GENTILE, M.D. (2920 North Swan Road, Suite 206, Tucson, Arizona 85712, area code 520-323-6440) who diagnosed JOHNSON with Tourettes' Syndrome and two other unknown dysfunction's. They stated GENTILE prescribed medication for JOHNSON.

The McWILLIAMS' stated they never saw JOHNSON in possession of any explosive devices, chemical or biological agents. They stated the only possessions they had that belonged to JOHNSON were his dirty clothing and his dog, BABY. They refused to give the reporting Inspectors consent to look at or search JOHNSON'S abandoned possessions. They stated they did not possess any of his writings or any computer related software or hardware.

They stated they had never heard the names "JIM BELL", "Toto", "Truthmonger" or "Human Gus Peter".

They admitted owning a personal computer (PC), but stated it was a very old system and that it was not set up or connected to the Internet. They stated JOHNSON never used their PC.
