Subject Matter/Remarks

RCMP Investigator STEVE FOSTER reported that he was investigating CARL EDWARD JOHNSON for possible violations of Canadian law relating to documents on JOHNSON's Internet web page. FOSTER advised that he had executed search warrants on JOHNSON's residence, his Internet Service Provider, and his telephone service provider. FOSTER advised that he also had obtained a laptop computer that Canadian Customs Officials seized from JOHNSON. FOSTER stated that on the computers he found numerous documents linking JOHNSON to the Cypherpunks group. FOSTER also provided the following information obtained during his investigation:

1. Documents obtained from the Internet Service Provider Sympatico from the Internet Web site www3.sk.sympatico.ca/carljohn/, including:
 - a. The "Dead Lucky" web site program, dated May 24, 1997. A test of the program revealed that when the user pushed the "submit" button, the program generated an electronic mail (e-mail) message to toto@sk.sympatico.ca. A review of the programming code of the page revealed that the interactive page would automatically e-mail a message to toto@sk.sympatico.ca containing all of the input information. (Files AP.htm and Submit.htm)
 - b. "Assassination Politics / The Final Frontier of Politics", including JIM BELL's complete 10 part Assassination Politics essay. (Files AP1-6 and AP7-10)
 - c. Information on "TOTO" (Tension Of The Opposites) with references to TOTO Enterprises and toto@sk.sympatico.ca.
 - d. "The Official Royal Canadian Mounted Police HATE Page"
 - e. Account registration documents showing the account was billed to Carl Johnson, 2423 Silver Place Kelowna BC (This is believed to be the suspect's father, CARL D. JOHNSON) and registered to LARRY WAYNE JOHNSON.
 - f. An Internet usage summary for the "carljohn" user ID showing 30 accesses to the carljohn Internet account on March 25, 1998.
 - g. An Alias file listing showing "toto : carljohn"

2. Documents obtained from the Canadian Telephone company SaskTel printout showing that 30 telephone calls were made at times corresponding to the carjohn Internet usage on March 25, 1998, from the phone line located at CARL E. JOHNSON's residence. The calls were made to the Internet access line for the Internet Service Provider Sympatico.
3. Copies of search warrant documents for the search warrant executed by RCMP on CARL JOHNSON's residence.
